In Preparing ALL Your Event Outfits ... please read the Dress Code carefully.



We request that all Esther Conference Female Participants adhere to holy, modest standards of dress.

Please choose your clothing, especially your formal dress wisely, carefully, prayerfully, and just right for you as a Child of God being presented before the Throne of Jesus.

Your clothing should have:

A Proper Neckline

- Maximum two finger widths below collarbone.
- If needed, wear and undershirt to meet this requirement.

A Proper Top for "Sleeveless" Dress

- Length should be 3/4 sleeve (covering elbow) or long sleeve undershirt.
- A bolero or coat accessory can be worn with the same sleeve and neckline requirement.
- Please do not wear tight, or visibly see-through/skin-colored garments.

A Proper Top for "Sleeved" Dress

- Length should be 3/4 sleeve (covering elbow) or long sleeve undershirt.
- Please do not wear tight, or visibly see-through/skin-colored garments.

A Proper Skirt Length

- Measurement is at the midpoint between the "back of your knee to your ankle", length should be no shorter than this midpoint and can be longer.
- Please do not wear tight, or visibly see-through/skin-colored garments.

A Proper Hairstyle and Accessories

- No crowns, tiaras, etc.; these are reserved for coronation attendees only.
- Natural, uncut, un-dyed, no hair pieces or extensions.
- No make-up, no rings, no bracelets, no earrings, no bracelet-type watches
- No fake nails or colored nails (including clear and French tip).
